

ECS DRESS CODE

The purpose of the ECS dress code is to promote modesty, teach students not to draw undue attention to themselves, and provide parents with an easy and cost-effective way to clothe their children. Adherence to the spirit of the policy can be an opportunity for character training that is most effectively done before the child ever arrives at school. Uniforms should be clean, neat and in good repair. Excessively worn or damaged clothing should be replaced. Please give particular attention to the spirit of the code with regard to jewelry, hair accessories, hairstyles, etc. The goal is to be clear without dictating every detail. If necessary, the administration reserves the right to revoke a student's privilege to choose.

Board appointed committee members may conduct periodic uniform inspections.

Administration will notify parents should their child be out of code.

The ECS Board will give particular attention to habitual offenders.

Should circumstances beyond your control occur such that the student cannot be in compliance with the uniform code (broken belt, muddy shoes), send a note so that the student can be excused from the code violation that day.

While normal field trip attire is the regular dress uniform, occasionally circumstances warrant a more casual dress which is specified by the administration. This may include the official monogrammed red school t-shirt from Southern School Uniforms, 1721 Eastern Bypass, and long blue jeans. In the event of extremely warm weather, the teacher **may** give the students *special* permission to wear shorts, skorts, or Capri pants.

Navy monogrammed short or long sleeved polo shirt, tucked & buttoned, top button optional
Shoes: No shoes over the ankle allowed
Brown or tan leather or suede closed toe, closed heel, shoes
Socks: Neutral or matching colors
Optional:
Khaki plain or pleated shorts

Cool Weather:

Navy Crested Pull-over Sweater/ECS fleece, monogrammed or crested
Plain white turtleneck may be layered underneath long sleeved monogrammed shirt or sweater

Tenth - Twelfth Grade Boys

Pant: Khaki long pants: plain or pleated, with belt loops (Light colored or olive colored khakis are not allowed)
Gray dress slacks; must be worn with black or cordovan leather closed toe, closed heel dress shoe and a belt that matches shoes.
Belt: Brown leather-like belt
Shirt: Light blue or white dress shirt with tie.
Yellow and French Blue button down shirt (**12th grade only**)
Sleeves will not be rolled above elbows.
Short sleeve dress shirts may be worn (with tie).
Same colors apply.
Tie: This will be at student/parent discretion.
We require mature and professional choices. The administration reserves the right to revoke a student's privilege to choose
